





displacement motor yacht, the exterior styling alone – with its expansive sections of glass and geometric references in the superstructure – would have been enough to capture the fash-

ion forward among yacht buyers. But when this styling was accompanied by an interior volume that is unrivalled in its size range and positioned atop an innovative High Performance Piercing Bow and hull design, the competition thinned out. As the Fast Displacement Series evolved and owners and the yard's naval architecture teams joined Cor at the drawing boards to incorporate new features and ingenious amenities, word spread about the exciting new FD Series, and those in the know agreed that the Horizon FD would be a yacht to watch.

Since the first FD Series yacht, an FD85, was unveiled at the Taiwan International Boat Show in 2016 and subsequently sold to a Japanese client, the series has grown to include the FD87, FD77, FD102

and the upcoming FD70, all offered in multiple layout configurations with endless options for customization. A series with global appeal, FD yachts are equally sought after by American,


European, Asian, and Australian owners.

# Horizon Yachts Celebrates the Launch of Twin RP110 Superyachts

Built for two clients who share a unique Horizon yacht ownership story, two RP110 Superyachts join their new owners on opposite continents.



#### It's a story of being separated at "berth" for

twin RP110 Superyachts, which recently launched and delivered to their respective owners in the U.S. and Australia. Despite hailing from different continents, these owners shared a unique yacht ownership path, which began in 2012 when they each purchased a Horizon E78. From there both moved into Horizon E88 yachts before commissioning their own RP110 Superyachts which, coincidentally, were tank tested together prior to being delivered in the same month.

The RP110 Hull 5 has been built for a third-time Horizon owner from the U.S. Featuring a double chine hull designed by Donald Blount, this RP110 is a true superyacht throughout, from style and amenities to performance.

Both owners each moved from an E78 to an E88 before commissioning a new RP110.



Within her 25' beam, the owner commissioned Italian designer Luca Dini to incorporate a casually elegant décor that pervades the spacious and flexible four-stateroom layout. Owing to Horizon's willingness to customize to owner specification, the salon of this RP110 has been fitted with an exquisite 150-bottle wine storage unit, which was customized to satisfy the oenophile owner's wine collection hobby.

Featuring exterior styling from J.C. Espinosa and an interior designed by Cor D. Rover, the second Horizon RP110, Hull 7, (featured on page 24) has been tailored to her Australian owners' preferences. Distinguished by an exterior profile that features floor-to-ceiling windows on the deckhouse and a dramatic dark blue hull, this yacht has been designed with a combined skylounge/open bridge configuration that offers an enclosed, climate-controlled skylounge for family gatherings as well as open visibility from the bridge. Measuring 10' 10", the swim platform is large enough to facilitate sunning and water sports and can easily launch a three-ton tender.

#### The FD77 Hull Two is not only the first Skyline

version of the model, it is also the first FD77 to be delivered to Australia. Incorporating the same exciting features that characterize the FD Series, such as large windows, an expansive 22'8" beam, and a striking exterior profile that presides atop Horizon's High Performance Piercing Bow hull design, the compact FD77 has been purposely designed for owner operation.

Fitted with numerous owner-inspired amenities, the FD77 Skyline offers four staterooms, including an on-deck master suite. The spacious master features large windows that bring copious natural light into the interior, a large en suite, and  $\rightarrow$ 









drawers. Three additional guest staterooms are  $\,$ found below deck – one VIP cabin at the bow, one large guest cabin amidships, and a twin cabin. The extended main salon features a bright and  $% \left( x\right) =\left( x\right) +\left( x$ contemporary décor with functional amenities,



such as the innovative convertible dining table that can easily folds up into a breakfast bar. The galley can be separated from the salon via privacy doors and a Hi/Lo island partition.

On the upper deck, the enclosed skylounge features a dayhead and a relaxed dinette area with low coffee tables. Doors to port and starboard provide access to the walkaround side decks.



#### Designed in collaboration with Cor D. Rover,

Horizon's Fast Displacement (FD) Series of motoryachts and superyachts is nothing short of head-turning, thanks in part to the oversized windows, voluminous interior, and well-planned entertaining spaces wrapped in a stylish package. While the exterior styling of this pioneering series—first introduced at the 2016 Taiwan International Boat Show —attracts attention, it is the hull platform and proprietary bow design that sets the series apart from similarly-styled yachts.

#### Tunnel

A properly designed tunnel will reduce resistance and decrease draft.

#### Hard chine

A hard chine at the bow ensures a dry ride and increases the lift force.

#### Soft chine

A soft chine mid-ship & aft in the hull generates smaller waves and reduces the resistance hump at hull speed.
This hull design delivers lower resistance and a smooth transition in all speed ranges for more efficient cruising.

#### High Performance Piercing Bow (HPPB):

The High Perormance Piercing Bow is not only designed for high efficiency but also for a greater hull speed. The submersed sharp bow underwater makes it easier to cut through underwater currents, so the HPPB increases the length of the waterline and reduces the entrance angle of the bow wave. This also enhances ride comfort in head seas by damping the motion while benefitting the hydrodynamic performance across the board.

#### Long skeg

The long skeg offers larger lateral underwater surface area and excellent directional stability. These two features offer good maneuverability and increase comfort for onboard guests.



Efficiency and performance must accompany style in yacht design, and such aspects formed the basis of the design conversation as the Fast Displacement series evolved to include new models. Comprised of a hybrid hull shape and tunnel design, Horizon's High Performance Piercing Bow (HPPB) delivers a shallow draft, more comfortable ride, lower resistance and excellent stability in comparison to a traditional fast displacement, hard-chine hull design.

The FD Series' hull features both hard and soft chines—a hard chine at the bow to increase lift force and a soft chine midship and aft to reduce resistance. A well-designed tunnel aft further reduces resistance and decreases draft. The sharp underwater bow protrusion cuts through currents with ease and reduces the entrance angle of the bow wave while increasing waterline length. This enhances ride comfort in head seas by damping the motion and improving hydrodynamic performance across the board. The HPPB design also features a long skeg that offers a longer lateral underwater surface area and yields excellent directional stability.

CFD and tank testing of the HPPB design resulted in across-the-board hydrodynamic improvements in comparison to a traditional design. While alternative bow designs that feature protrusions work efficiently at either high or slower speeds, the HPPB delivers lower resistance and a smooth transition in all speed ranges, bringing both efficiency at slower speeds and performance at higher speeds.

Returning from a 5242nm journey from Taiwan to Australia aboard his brand new yacht, the owner of the FD85 Julind said, "Although we encountered some reasonably rough seas upwards of 5 meters, the FD85 is a unbelievable sea vessel. She came into her own and performed flawlessly. The combination the FD hull along with the lighter superstructure and the stabilizer is a fantastic outcome."

The success of the HPPB is a milestone for Horizon's highly trained and experienced research team as they continue their efforts to innovate. First implemented on the FD85 and FD87 Skyline models, the HPPB design is now standard for the FD Series − further proving these luxury yachts as truly revolutionary. ⇔

This is also a significant build for Horizon, as it represents the largest, most luxurious Horizon yacht to ever be delivered to the Southern Hemisphere and takes the position as a flagship vessel for The Horizon Group worldwide.

Having built 780 of custom yachts over the last three decades, Horizon has gained a reputation for flexibility in design and construction. This willingness to collaborate with its owners is one of the many distinguishing features that set Horizon apart as a yacht builder. Because clients are able to build a vessel that truly suits their boating lifestyle, Horizon enjoys a high number of repeat clients, who appreciate the collaborative design and build process and effortless customization that Horizon provides.

For this experienced Australian owner, the design of *The Legion* began at the drawing board with a review of the established Horizon RP110 platform, designed by J.C. Espinosa, to which the owner requested a hull extension of five feet as well as the addition of a ten-foot, ten-inch swim platform – customizations that resulted in a total LOA of 121' 10" and allowed for an enlarged aft deck entertaining area and a custom beach club equipped with a sauna.

To execute his innovative spatial concepts and lifestyle requirements for the yacht's interior, the owner turned to renowned designer Cor D. Rover, the creative mind behind the acclaimed Fast Displacement Series. Maximizing the additional space afforded by the hull extension, Rover and the Horizon design team incorporated a spacious interior layout within the 25' beam, with floating floors for sound attenuation and high-end detailing






spacious yet homey main salon, a 10ft hand-cut crystal chandelier serves as the centerpiece.

To accommodate her ten guests, *The Legion* offers a large main-deck master suite and four staterooms forward on the lower deck. Quarters for four crew are situated aft. The master is exceptionally well laid out with a king-sized bed, a shower steam room, fiber optic star overhead lighting feature, full-height walk-in wardrobe, and natural stone surfaces.

The spacious lower deck staterooms continue the Art Deco theme of the salon, with hi-gloss ebony timber and black and gold accents. Guest areas are decorated with high-end designer furniture from Bylgari, Gucci, Fendi, and Versace, echoing the tone of luxury that defines the vessel.

Deck areas are maximized aboard *The Legion*, which features a walkaround design on the main deck that links the spacious forward bow seating area for ten guests to the expansive aft dining and





bar area. Two day heads have also been specified for this deck, the second situated aft to accommodate guests from the swim platform and exterior areas.

Designed to provide the ultimate indoor/ outdoor experience, the spacious flybridge features a custom designed octagonal Jacuzzi for ten, a bar, and entertainment area. Two Sea-Doo Jetskis and a Steelhead 2500 hydraulic davit are also stored furthest aft on this deck.

The owner's most noteworthy implementation was the custom built carbon fiber swim platform from Artifex that easily accommodates the Scout 255 LXF tender. Fitted to this superyacht is an impressive customized Besenzoni stainless steel

passerelle; the largest ever installed by Horizon.

The Legion is fitted with twin MTU V16 2600hp engines, the latest state-of-the-art Furuno Black Box navigation package, OctoPlex system, upgraded 440/20X ABT-Trac stabilizers, Yacht Controller, and an electric sunroof. The eye-catching profile is further enhanced by a deep navy blue hull which is dramatically set off at night by 28 blue underwater lights fitted around the hull.

Making her Australian debut at the Sanctuary Cove International Boat Show in May, *The Legion* is another benchmark of innovation for Horizon. She is now cruising with her owners and will call the beautiful Whitsunday Islands her home port.  $\Leftrightarrow$





# Happy Hour with JIM LOOMIS

For Jim Loomis, the owner of the **Horizon FD85 Christine**, the ocean is always calling. He recently sold his E88 and now has his eyes set on a new FD87.



WHEN IT COMES TO BOATS, JIM LOOMIS IS AS PASSIONATE AS IT GETS. THE PROUD OWNER OF THE FD85 *CHRISTINE*, MR. LOOMIS SPOKE WITH OUR EDITORS JUST AFTER FINISHING A CALL WITH THE REPRESENTATIVES AT HORIZON YACHT USA ABOUT A BRAND NEW FD87 SKYLINE.

Q: Let's talk about your boating history "My father and I started boating on the Chesapeake Bay and the North East River when I was about eight or nine years old," Jim recalls. "My first boat was a rowboat; the second was a plywood boat with an Evinrude engine." By the time he was 15, Jim was enjoying the wind in his hair aboard a 16ft Crestliner he had fitted with a racing engine. "After that we just continued to leap forward in boats," he says. "When I was in my 20s I started fishing and my father – who is now over 100 years old – and I built a sportfish together at Jersey Yachts. Then I started on my own."


The yachts Jim has owned over the years reads like a who's who of production builders, his first being a 74ft Hatteras, followed by a couple of Lazzaras and a Cheoy Lee 103. "I've owned quite a few boats," he says. "I had a Lazzara and saw a Horizon E88 at a boat show, so I bought the E88 and traded the Lazzara. A year later, I'm at the Fort Lauderdale International Boat Show and I see this brand new FD85." The stars aligned and Jim was able to trade his E88 to another set of Horizon owners and take delivery of his new FD85.

## Q: Tell us about Christine

All of Jim's boats have been named Christine, in honor of his daughter. "I have a part time Captain, but I usually run the boat myself," he says. "I keep her behind my house in Ocean Reef along with our 53ft Hydra-Sports center console. We actually tow that behind the big boat. I may not have the biggest yacht but I have the biggest tender in the marina!

"I've been running boats my whole life and I also fly jets," says Jim. "I like to go fast. My E88 wasn't a fast boat, but she wasn't slow. At first I was concerned about the speed with a large fast displacement boat like the FD85. But, when you look at the space you get with the FD85 — you have a spacious, modern, well-designed boat with an on-deck master and four big staterooms below... well, I'm learning to put up with the slower speed."

With all that space and styling comes some serious performance in rough weather, as Jim and his wife experienced during one Bahamas crossing. "We had eight- to- ten-foot seas; it was some pretty nasty weather, and I was very pleased with how the boat handled. In 35 knots the boat did fantastic. Even my wife, who usually gets seasick said she was very comfortable under the circumstances."











# Q: How do you like to use your Horizon?

From their home in Ocean Reef, Florida, Jim and his wife take Christine to the Bahamas where they cruise the Exumas or visit Atlantis or, when the yacht is up in Avalon, New Jersey, Jim and his son will run it up to Nantucket to rendezvous with family during the summer months.

Jim says he enjoys just being out on the water with his family and grandkids. "We take turns with the Captain running the boat. I'm not big on entertaining, I just enjoy boating and being with family." Jim says his entire family loves the space afforded by the FD85 and, with the 53-footer as a tender, there is plenty of opportunity for fishing and diving excursions.

#### **0**: What's next?

Jim and his family have owned their FD85 for a little over a year but he's already looking at his next Horizon and plans to stay in the FD Series. "I can't go too big, though, or it won't fit behind my home!" he says.

"The new FD87 has five big cabins for my family and guests. With this yacht there are a lot of new features, like the forward deck lounge that has refrigeration and storage as well as the open galley. That's a big difference," he says.

"I like my boat now," Jim says of the Open Bridge configuration on the FD85, "When we go to the Bahamas we open it up to enjoy the breeze. But having the skylounge enclosed [in the FD87 Skyline] in nasty weather will be ideal."

While experienced owners like Jim know that Horizon offers its clients great flexibility when it comes to customization, he said he hasn't added any new features. "I usually take the yachts as they are. I think Horizon does a really good job. They take care of their owners."
