#### **CEO MESSAGE**

## STEADY THROUGH THE STORM

#### The COVID-19 pandemic has impacted business

and economies all over the world. Thanks to swift and strict prevention strategies adopted early in 2020, however, Taiwan has experienced only a minimal impact. Because of this, the Horizon Group has been able to continue normal daily operations without disruption. We've experienced only minor delays in the delivery of some imported equipment, our staff has been able to continue working as usual and our delivery commitments have been maintained.

At the same time, the pandemic caused an interesting phenomenon in terms of sales in the international yacht market. With many cities around the world locked down due to travel restrictions, social distancing rules limiting business interactions and nearly all of the major boat shows being cancelled or scaled back in 2020, the traditional way of doing business has changed dramatically.

Horizon has not been spared this effect. Not surprisingly, new orders in late 2020 experienced a sharp decline of more than 50% when compared with the same period of last year. While this is a concerning statistic, it is interesting to note that stock and second-hand boats on the market are hotly traded and almost sold out. From these two extreme situations, I can tell that the demand in the yacht market remains strong and the market did not shrink as a result of the outbreak. Buyers simply seem to be leaning toward purchasing off-the-shelf boats rather than waiting for a custom-built yacht. Time will tell if this is a fleeting trend or a new norm.

In the final months of 2020, Horizon will continue to move forward and complete our goals as planned; we have successfully achieved our production targets for this year, and we are moving ahead with the completion of our



future goals as outlined below:

- $\cdot$ A \$15M U.S. renovation and expansion of the Horizon shipyard, to officially open in Spring 2021
- · Horizon Yacht USA has relocated into new, expanded offices in North Palm Beach, FL
- The latest CNC milling system, purchased from PaR USA, will be delivered to Horizon's CNC Tooling Center in February 2021
- · Atech Composites has successfully developed 6D infusion technology with patents pending
- · In addition to the development of new models, the Horizon R&D team is also working on a new propeller design and a vibration testing system for sea trials

While the seas are currently rough for many yacht builders, Horizon's commitment to the future has underscored its strength amidst the competition. Horizon will continue to invest in infrastructure, in equipment, and in developing new technologies, which I believe will lead Horizon Yachts to play an even greater role in the world's yachting industry after the storm has subsided.







Horizon's engineers accommodated the request by designing a hull form that accommodates a lightweight carbon fiber flybridge without compromising performance. Perched atop the proven High-Performance Piercing Bow and hull design, the FD92 maintains a wide 23' 3" beam and the voluminous interior that defines the Cor D. Rover-designed FD Series.






# WHAT'S ON TREND FOR YACHT INTERIOR DESIGN 2021?


Horizon's in-house design teams share their insights into tomorrow's trends.



Champagne colors. Japandi. Glass and chrome. Minimalism. The design trends for 2021 borrow from the past while looking toward the future.

The teams at Horizon's two in-house Design Centers discuss the trends they are implementing in both smaller and larger yachts while lending their expertise to styles and looks that will inspire and turn heads in 2021.





#### 1 // THE PALETTE

A warm and neutral color palette is the background of the 2021 yacht interior. Unlike the Scandi style that favors pure white, a warm or neutral background complements muted colors and natural hues, like brown and beige. No longer boring and conservative, beige has seen a comeback for providing a serene neutral tone upon which textures and pops of color can add visual interest. Champagnes and other variations of beige add elegance while grey and black accents add drama without being overbearing.



The 2021 interior design finds common ground between bright and cold colors. Add cooler hues of muted pink, blue and green, warmed up with earthy details and wooden elements. Pops of color can also be introduced, but only when used sporadically so as to not interrupt the harmony of the design.

The floor plan for 2021 is open and transparent. Individual living spaces now make way for integrated areas comprising the kitchen, dining and living spaces. This not only opens the area for socializing purposes but extends the overall interior look. An ongoing design trend is the use of full-height glass elements to extend the feeling of a space and to marry interior with exterior.

#### 2 // NATURAL ELEMENTS

Natural, tactile accents are on trend for 2021, so invite nature to join you onboard! Choose high quality furniture constructed of simple and natural materials, such as mid-toned wood with exposed grain. Match furniture with natural, textured fabrics like linen.

Light woods are a popular material for yacht interiors as they create a comfortable, homey atmosphere. This material can be used not only for flooring, but also for wall coverings and ceilings. Use light, untreated woods to highlight multipurpose spaces.

When working with a neutral space, texture is key. Add interest by combining different yet complementary materials and textures for a touch of natural simplicity. For warmth, soft, tactile fabrics make a space cozier. Add linen cushions, fuzzy rugs in a plain color, a statement wall art piece in neutral tones, or a living plant to serve as a focalpoint – what better way to achieve the natural look and blend the indoors with the outdoors than with plants and greenery?





#### 3 // FINISHES

Natural elements like wood, metal, glass and stone are the dominant materials in 2021. Coated metals in bronze, iron grey or black lend an unobtrusive, yet refined look, and are swiftly usurping polished stainless steel. Thanks to advances in technology, engineered stone is now a great alternative to natural stone. It is durable, non-porous, and offers a variety of unique patterns and high-contrast veining.

In the galley, eschew shiny surfaces for relaxing, matte finishes. Only metal accents should shine in this space.

Stylish galley designs blend wood with concrete, metal with stone, or glass with artificial materials. It's also a space where you can have fun, so be bold by combining various textures of one material or similar materials in different colors.

Luxurious head design also remains a focus for 2021. White marble or quartz are timeless and sophisticated materials that can be used for flooring and wall coverings as well as countertops, and beautifully complement woods and metal accents for an instantly luxurious look.

#### 4 // HIDDEN FUNCTIONALITY

Because space is critical within a yacht's interior, multifunctional furniture provides flexibility and versatility. A foldable dining table can be transformed to a sofa table or breakfast bar to permit open space for gathering or wider circulation. The hi/lo table can be casual at coffee table height or formal at dining height, and an extendable function fulfills the needs for both intimate family dinners or a large feast. Keep in mind, however, that these pieces should not only be functional and fit the space, but must be visually interesting as well.

Solid cabinet doors hiding shelves and organizers are also on trend for 2021. Floor-to-ceiling galley cabinets are both functional and stylish, or a modern galley can incorporate low cabinets only for a spacious and luxurious look.









#### 5 // LIGHTING

Never underestimate the importance of lighting in yacht design! Highlight natural lighting wherever possible, taking care to not block windows with heavy furniture or cabinetry. Incorporate smart technology fiber optic lighting, which offers many advantages, such as being heat free, simple to install, safe, precise, durable and easily maintained. Fiber optic lighting also allows for a variety of colors and programmed settings that can shift from starry night to party mode at the touch of a button.

Less clutter and cleaner lines define 2021's look, and simple lighting designs blend perfectly into modern decors. Low-profile fixtures with soft colors and simple geometric designs that follow the Minimalism trend are becoming even more popular. Linear fixtures and track lights also bring harmony and the perfect amount of intentional light to a space.





#### 6 // MATERIALS

Complementing the neutral palette and natural finishes, a textured fabric or wallpaper with contoured lines, vivid patterns or colors remains popular.

Leather is another preferred and durable material, as it brings a sense of quality and luxury to an interior, holds up against sun exposure and wears well when cared for. Incorporate leather into your interior as an accent piece, a wall covering, or a piece of furniture for that casually elegant look.

pioneer is an understatement. Founded in 2000, Atech specializes in advanced composites, producing not only the hull, decks and superstructure of every Horizon yacht, but also providing Fiber Reinforced Plastics (FRP) components across multiple industries in Asia and beyond.

For the past two decades, Atech has remained at the forefront of advanced resin infusion molding technology. Atech was the first licensee in Asia to utilize TPI Composites' patented SCRIMP (Seemann's Composites Resin Infusion Molding Process) vacuum infusion process, a construction method developed by the U.S. Navy as a means to increase a vessel's strength and durability without adding weight or affecting performance.

The benefits of resin infusion are well known, as it allows for continuous and flawless resin distribution throughout the laminates while also nearly eliminating the emission of VOCs (Volatile Organic Compounds). In 2004, Horizon developed an improved 3D resin infusion technology that transforms the original 2D resin flow on surfaces to 3D flow, which climbs up and down internal stiffeners, enabling the build of far larger structures than previously possible. In the past, the stiffeners could only be constructed through hand lamination, which meant increased weight and less structural integrity. By utilizing the infusion technology, the resin can flow in all directions instead of only in a planar direction, and the stiffeners can be integrated with the yacht during the infusion, making the yacht both stronger and lighter.

This year, Atech further refined its 3D infusion capabilities by introducing and patenting 6D vacuum infusion technology. This process infuses a yacht hull with 3D-infused macro structure of the longitudinal girders and transverse frame with the 3D-infused micro structure glass fabric cloth. This revolutionary process guarantees more efficient and even resin distribution throughout the lamination, thus ensuring a consistency of quality and allowing for the single-process construction of hulls over 140 feet.

But it's not just the infusion process that sets Atech apart.

Not only are all raw materials rigorously tested, the company also invests heavily in inspection of its composite structures and

applies aerospace-grade non-destructive testing technology through a Laser Shearography System.

Atech's continuous investment and innovation in technology not only serves to enhance the performance and quality of all Horizon yachts, it sets the standard by which the yacht building industry at large can advance.  $\Leftrightarrow$





In June 2020, the pop of the champagne cork punctuated the first page of that next chapter and the christening of the Copham's brand new Horizon FD102  $T\dot{O}$ - $KAL\dot{O}N$ . Befitting her name inspired by one of the couple's favorite vineyards as well as Plato's concept of beauty,  $T\dot{O}$ - $KAL\dot{O}N$  indeed exudes beauty throughout and is poised to be one of Horizon's flagship builds. Designed to accommodate ten guests in five spacious staterooms, including a full-beam, on-deck master, the 102ft yacht boasts a sleek profile that belies her impressive interior volume – one of the hallmarks of the FD Series – and features numerous customizations throughout.

Welcomed by a spacious aft deck featuring a pleasant seating area with a bar, storage and television to starboard, guests enter the main deck through curved opening glass doors to be greeted by a delightful semi-al fresco dining area hosting an extendable round table set beneath a custom circular light fixture. During the build process, the Cophams traveled to the Horizon yard in Taiwan to make the final materials and finishes selections at Horizon's in-house design center. During this visit, the yard also mocked up a full-scale replica of the aft dining area to ensure table dimensions, chair heights and clearance were absolutely perfect.

Inspired Features — Galley Partition





Oak, wenge and zebra woods feature prominently throughout  $T\dot{O}\text{-}KAL\dot{O}N$ 's main and upper deck guest areas, which were designed in collaboration with Cor D. Rover and Horizon's in-house design team. Numerous customized touches have been incorporated throughout, from the backlit mullions highlighting the salon to the customized galley fitted with professional-grade appliances. The owners also specified a carved design in the opaque Hi/Lo partition that separates the galley from the salon.





Configured to accommodate ten guests in five spacious staterooms including an on-deck master, *TÒ-KALÒN* maximizes her impressive interior volume, which is augmented by a 25' 3" beam. A his-and-hers en suite and his-and-hers walk-in closets complement the full-beam master stateroom, which resides just forward of the galley, powder room and custom wine cabinet - built and designed to store some of the family's favorite To Kalon vintage wine. Storage was maximized throughout the yacht, and the four additional guest staterooms on the lower deck feature thoughtful customizations, multiple closets and beech, wenge and bird's eye maple wood finishes.






On the upper deck, the Cophams requested a semi-enclosed skylounge with sliding glass windows that allows the majority of this deck to function as an uninterrupted indoor/outdoor space. Just aft of the fully enclosed pilothouse, an oversized U-shaped seating area opposite a full bar with fixed bar stools and a dayhead is protected from the elements under the hard top. The deck area aft is fitted with an extendable dining table for up to 12, a BBQ and a Jacuzzi tub for six with a bar counter and fixed stools. This portion of the deck is easily shaded by an  $\,$ electric retractable awning. Situating the tender storage on the bow and removing the starboard staircase from the aft deck to the flybridge further maximized this space, which will be a preferred area for entertaining family and friends.



# FD75

Designed for the U.S. market, the second FD75 propels the

standard for owner/operator yachts to the next level.





#### When the first FD75 made its world debut at the 2020 Horizon Open House

in Taiwan, the yacht received immediate praise for its efficient layout and ingenious details. Taking its place at the entrance of the acclaimed Cor D. Rover-designed FD Series, the FD75 model is itself a remarkable achievement in terms of design and naval architecture, as it features a raised pilothouse configuration that accommodates both an open bridge and a lower helm area and offers an on-deck master and spacious main deck all within a 20' 4" beam.

Following closely on the heels of Hull One, which is available for the European market, Hull Two launched on schedule from Horizon's Vision Shipyard and was shipped to the U.S. to make her own highly-anticipated grand debut. Designed for the American market, this newest FD75 is guaranteed to turn heads as she is unveiled to clients and special guests this winter in Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

Like her predecessor, this latest FD75 offers a four-stateroom layout, with a full-beam master on the main deck and three additional staterooms on the lower deck. Quarters for two crew are situated aft of the engine room. But that is where the similarities end.



Innovation in engineering allowed for a split pilothouse/master stateroom arrangement.

The on-deck master stateroom is another unique feature of this owner/operator model, and the FD75 maximizes the space forward of the salon and pilothouse where the master resides in a split-level arrangement, accessed down four steps from the semi-raised pilothouse. Spanning the yacht's full beam, the master stateroom enjoys private access from the main deck and features a king-sized bed accompanied by a seating area and built-in vanity. The en suite features dual washbasins and quartz countertops and flooring.



Boarding the yacht from the aft deck, which is outfitted with a built-in sofa and freestanding furnishings, the open layout and impressive volume of the FD75 is readily apparent. Fully opening glass doors provide access to the main salon and the biggest departure in design from Hull One: a galley-aft arrangement.

This galley-aft configuration, which is unique for the American market, allows for the entire aft portion of the main deck to operate as one large entertaining space. Situated to starboard, the galley is fully equipped with SubZero freezer drawers and a separate icemaker, and a wine cooler is fitted just forward. The galley counter extends halfway along the salon entrance, so that when the doors are fully opened, a fold-up counter creates a walk-up bar serving the aft deck.

Opposite the galley area, a convertible dining table provides added flexibility, serving as either a formal dining table or a casual breakfast bar. A fixed U-shaped leather sofa is joined by a coffee table with storage and faces a cabinet hiding the pop-up rotating television designed to minimize interference with the floor-to-ceiling views.

On the lower deck, a full-beam midships ensuite VIP is accompanied by a single-bed stateroom to port that offers additional storage closets and cabinets. A convertible twin stateroom is opposite to starboard. A shared en suite serving the single and twin staterooms is situated in the companionway along with a washer/dryer unit and additional storage.

Providing a secondary option for navigation at night or in inclement weather, the  $semi\mbox{-}raised\ pilothouse\ is\ situated\ within\ steps\ of\ the\ master\ stateroom\ and\ is\ highlighted$ in black vinyl and carbon accents.

Accessed via either the starboard exterior staircase or from the internal pilothouse, the open flybridge is a spacious and inviting area. Offering a dayhead, a television, a built-in bar with fixed stools, built-in seating, a BBQ and GE freezer, this lovely al fresco space echoes the richly serene color scheme and slatted wood design elements found on the lower deck.

The boat deck aft comfortably stores the tender, which is launched and retrieved by a Steelhead GS 1500 davit. Dual helm chairs facilitate navigation, and dual bump-outs to port and starboard assist with docking operations. Forward, a full sunpad and seating area invite relaxation on the foredeck.

Designed with the yard's proprietary High-Performance Piercing Bow and hull design that affords optimal comfort and performance, this latest FD75 is powered by twin Caterpillar C18 ACERTs of 1,136bhp. An efficient engine package, high-performance hull design, innovative naval architecture and voluminous interior ensures that this FD75 will set a brand new standard in owner/operator design. 👄

These Horizon PC60 owners make friends and memories while escaping COVID-19 in The Bahamas.

## FOR SO MANY PEOPLE AROUND THE WORLD, BEING UNABLE TO ENJOY THOSE SMALL THINGS THAT ARE SO OFTEN TAKEN FOR GRANTED HAS BECOME THE VERY THING EVERYONE MISSES THE MOST.





#### Alec and Barbara Hammond are the owners of the

Horizon Power Catamaran PC60, Ptolemy. Built in 2015, Ptolemy is the second Horizon PC60 for these repeat Horizon yacht owners, who commissioned the four-stateroom yacht to suit their retirement lifestyle.

When the COVID-19 pandemic began spreading across the globe and The Bahamas closed its doors to visitors in late March 2020, the Hammonds decided to hunker down aboard their 60ft power catamaran and enjoy the enhanced solitude of their favorite cruising grounds.

#### SOLITUDE AND COMRADERIE IN STANIEL CAY

"After two months in mostly solitary isolation in the Ragged Islands in the 'deepest corner' of The Bahamas, we are beginning to turn towards the north and are now in the Exuma Islands," writes Alec. "We spent a few days in our favorite anchorage at Big Farmer's Cay where, once again, no other cruising boats were to be seen."

Ptolemy then moved on to the popular Big Major's anchorage at Staniel Cay where they were the sole vessel in the sheltered anchorage that normally hosts 25 to 30 boats during the height of the season. They wouldn't be alone for long, however.

"We have been keeping in touch with three Horizon Power Catamarans on their 1,200-mile passage from the Virgin Islands to Fort Lauderdale," says Alec.

Since everyone had been self-isolating on their boats for several weeks, the Hammonds decided to take the opportunity of having the beautiful Staniel Cay anchorage to themselves and host a pot luck evening. It was a sight to see, as the three Horizon PCs slipped into the anchorage and a mini Horizon PowerCat Rendezvous between two PC60s, a PC65 and the Horizon Power Catamaran PC74 flagship, Seaglass took over the scenic destination. Sunset cocktails, a delicious potluck dinner, and flowing drinks and frivolity ensued! The trio resumed the journey the next day, "some, I'm delighted to say, were nursing raging hangovers!" says Alec.

"We stayed another twenty-four hours nursing our own hangovers and then slipped onto the fuel dock at Staniel Cay Yacht Club where we were welcomed by an old local friend, Brooks, who had also slipped in for fuel," writes Alec.

But getting diesel during the limited service and supply situation created by the COVD-19 pandemic would turn out to be a bit more drama than originally anticipated. For five long hours, *Ptolemy* sat at the dock as the dockmaster tried to get the pump to work without success. Thankfully, the pump was fixed by the next day and the dockmaster messaged the owners so *Ptolemy* could return to fill up with 400 gallons of fuel and head to the Staniel Cay Marina dock for the night.

"We continue to enjoy the company of sharks under the boat most of the time. When we see them in the underwater lights at night, we think of them as our guard dogs!!"

For so many people around the world, being unable to enjoy those small things that are so often taken for granted has become the very thing everyone misses the most. This night at the Staniel Cay Marina would be the first night *Ptolemy* was not on anchor somewhere for close to three months. While the marina, bar and restaurant were officially closed, the staff arranged for a lovely steak dinner to be delivered to the boat.

"Whilst most folk back home, or wherever they may be during this awful time, can get restaurants or bars to deliver or maybe go to a drive-by window for a meal, this was the first dinner not cooked on board by Barbara for more than eighty days, so it was quite something to celebrate and enjoy!"

"The lovely Debbie, who sent the package from Oxford Products back in the U.K., had slipped in a couple of magazines to keep a sad old classic car nut happy," writes Alec. "Thanks Debbie!"

The delicious steak dinner leftovers made for another satisfying lunch the following day. "Being a sensible chap," says Alec, "I didn't eat the fat from around the edge, instead coated it in mustard and fed it to the nagging black-headed gulls, which is always entertaining!"
